So to become a Pilot, basic knowledge in Mathematics and Physics, sound English with good communication skills, a very good technical aptitude and of course good health are mandatory.

Accelerated Package Program

FRUITIVE and AWFA has designed a training package exclusively for Indian Students. Indian students need to complete training in a faster time frame will benefit from accelerated program. This program include all of your training, charts, books, examiner fees, housing, transportation and conversion requirements as per DGCA, India.

The accelerated package will be completed within 8 months. Our Accelerated Training Course is designed to take a typical student from the very beginning to completion in the shortest time possible. The courses are not some watered down version, but rather condensing all of the same materials and skill training into a shorter

span of time. A typical accelerated student can expect to be a "full time" student over the entire span of the course. It is an intense immersion into the world of Flying, a sort of "Aviation Boot Camp".

AWFA trains Indian students to meet FAA pilot certificate requirements. However, once a student returns to India, should apply for conversion of foreign license to an Indian license with DGCA. There will be certain exams that have to be passed to do the appropriate conversion. FRUITIVE takes care of the ground school requirements for conversion.

Requirements

- ▶ Age : 18 Years.
- ▶ Educational Qualifications: A pass in HSC (Maths / Physics) or equivalent.
- ▶ You must be able to read, write and understand the English language.

Commercial Pilot Program

For becoming as a Pilot, one should undergo this program. The Commercial Pilot Certificate permits pilots to fly aircraft for compensation or hire. Commercial pilots are entitled to perform a variety of commercial activities. Additional training and certification is needed for "Air Taxi" and "Air Carrier" operations such as charter and airlines and this training varies according to the flights models.

There are two packages offered.

- ▶ Package I: 207 hrs +12.5 hrs Simulator (Cessna 150, Cessna 172 & Piper Seneca II)
- ▶ Package II: 207 hrs +12.5 hrs Simulator (Piper Warrior, Cessna 172& Piper Seneca II)

AWFA- SUNSEA ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

- ▶ Prospectus with application forms can be had from SUNSEA or downloaded from the web site.
- ▶ Fill up the SUNSEA and AWFA Applications for Enrollment, enclose the necessary documents and forward to SUNSEA Aviation Services Private Limited, I Floor, 51, Motilal Street, T.Nagar, Chennai 600 017 accompanied by the enrollment fee.
- ▶ Instructions to fill the applications.
 - ♦ Give genuine information.
 - ♦ Fill all the columns legibly by CAPITAL LETTERS.
 - ♦ Affix recent color photos.
 - ♦ Send color photocopy of your first and last page of your PP
 - ♦ Self attest by putting your signature in the bottom of the all photocopies.
- ▶ Please note that any wrong information or forged documents will lead to permanent Visa refusal.
- ▶ On acceptance of your application, you have to sign a "SUNSEA Student Agreement".
- ▶ Your application will be forwarded to AWFA for getting I20. The normal period is two weeks to get Immigration Certificate (I20). This will facilitate you to get M1 US Visa.
- ▶ When your Application for Enrollment has been accepted, the Immigration Certificate (I20) will be sent to SUNSEA . The I20 will confirm your course enrollment and start date
- ▶ SUNSEA will get you appointment with the FAA Authorized Medical Officer at Mumbai/Delhi. You need to get FAA Class I Medical Fitness Certificate.
- ▶ SUNSEA will assist you for an appointment with the nearest American Embassy or US Consulate Office. SUNSEA guides you in Visa Documentation and Personal Interview Preparation.
- ▶ After receipt of VISA, you should plan for your departure to AWFA. You have to wire transfer the first instalment of course fee one week before the date of departure. You should contact SUNSEA for travel arrangements and for the overseas medical insurance.
- ▶ AWFA takes care of your Finger Print registration and TSA Registration once you reach there.
- ▶ Normally it will take one-week time to get approval for flying from TSA after the fingerprint registration.
- ▶ On successful completion of the course, you have to return to India.
- ▶ SUNSEA will be assisting you for DGCA Conversion formalities.
